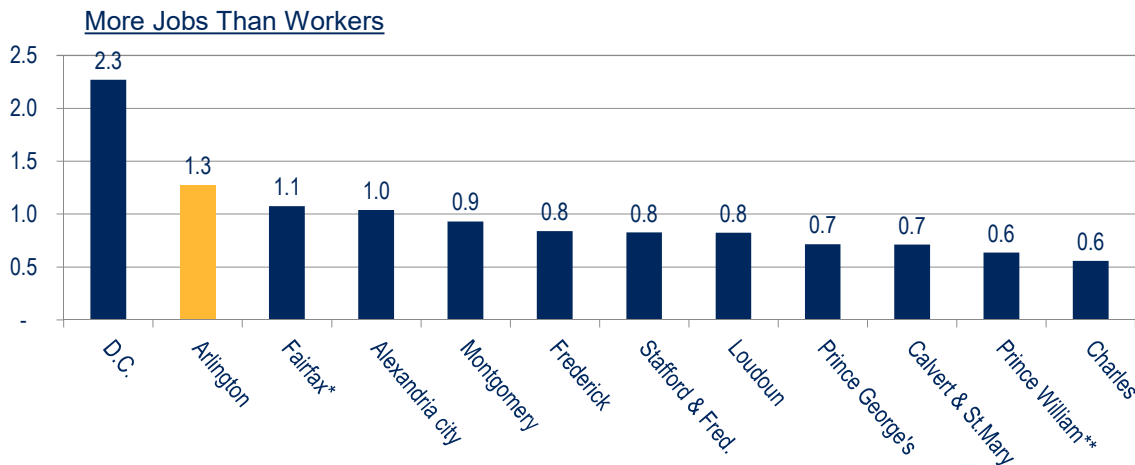

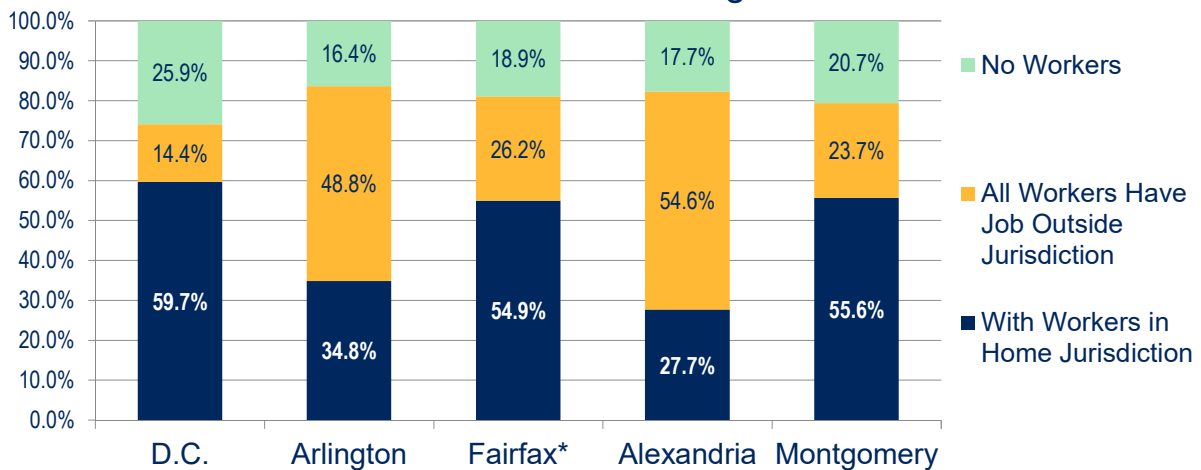
Primary Jobs to Resident-Worker Ratio 2015-2017 Average

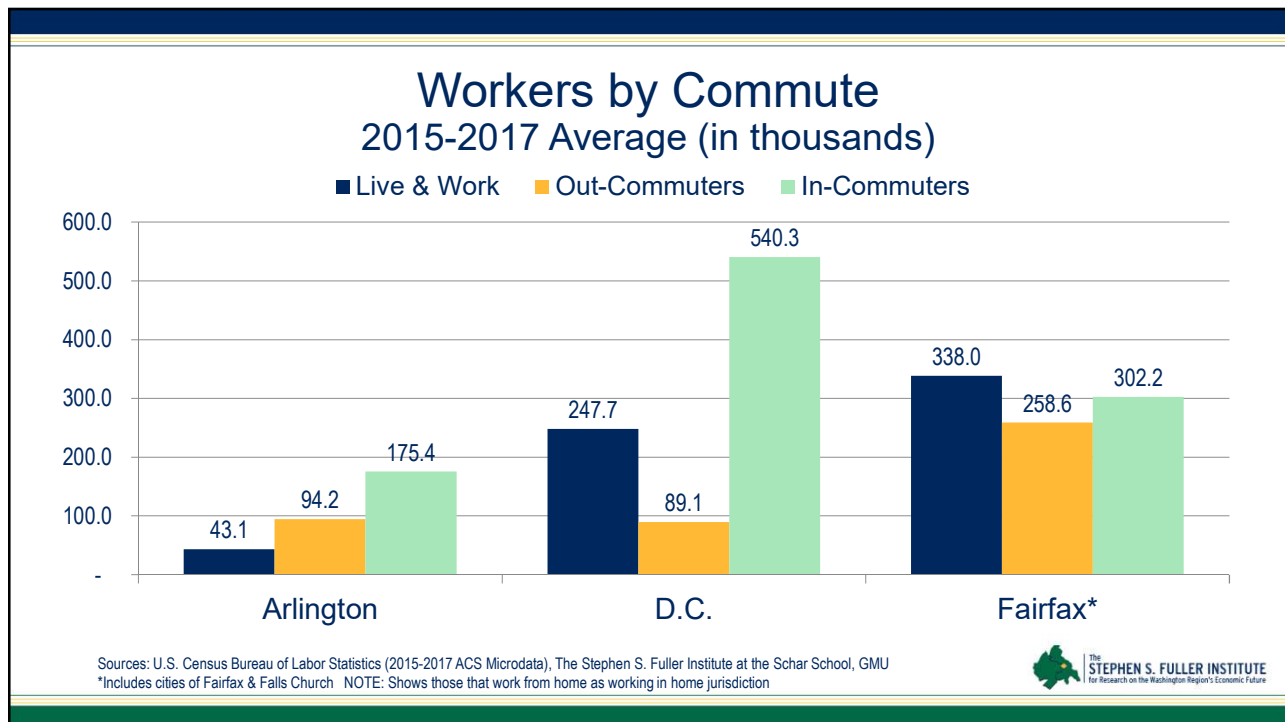


Household Characteristics: Select Jurisdictions 2015-2017 Average

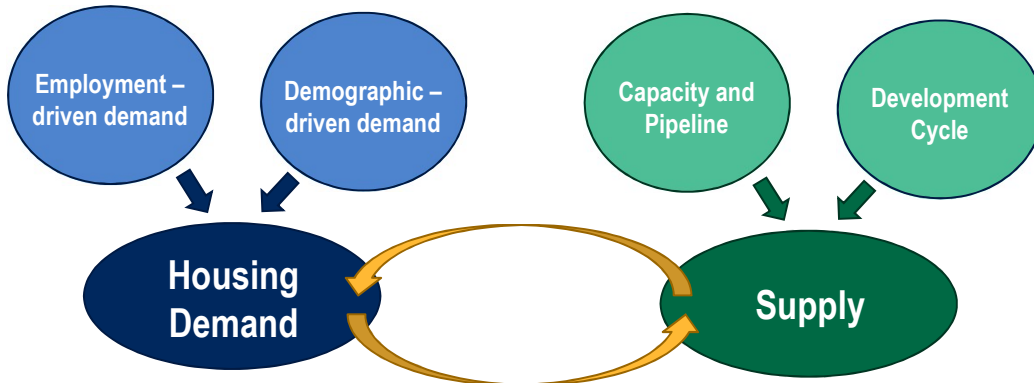




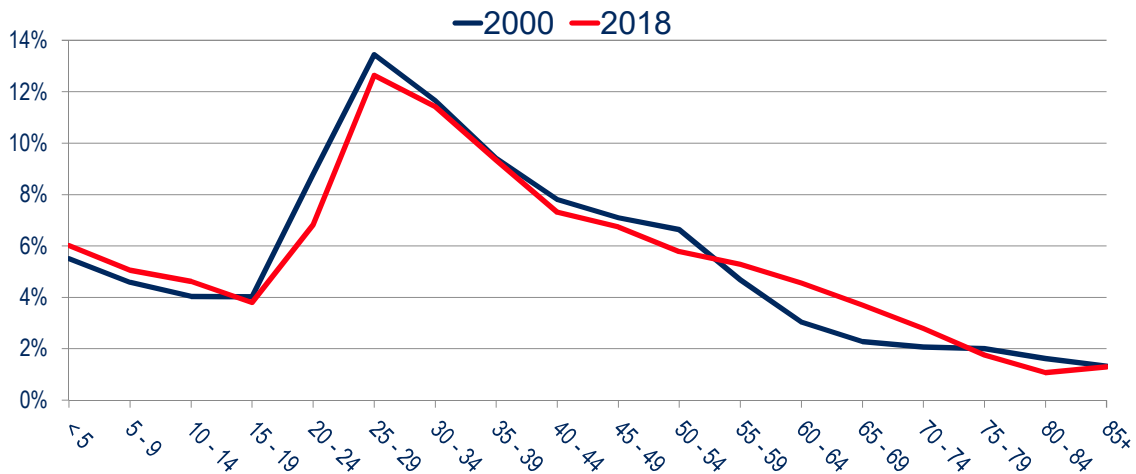

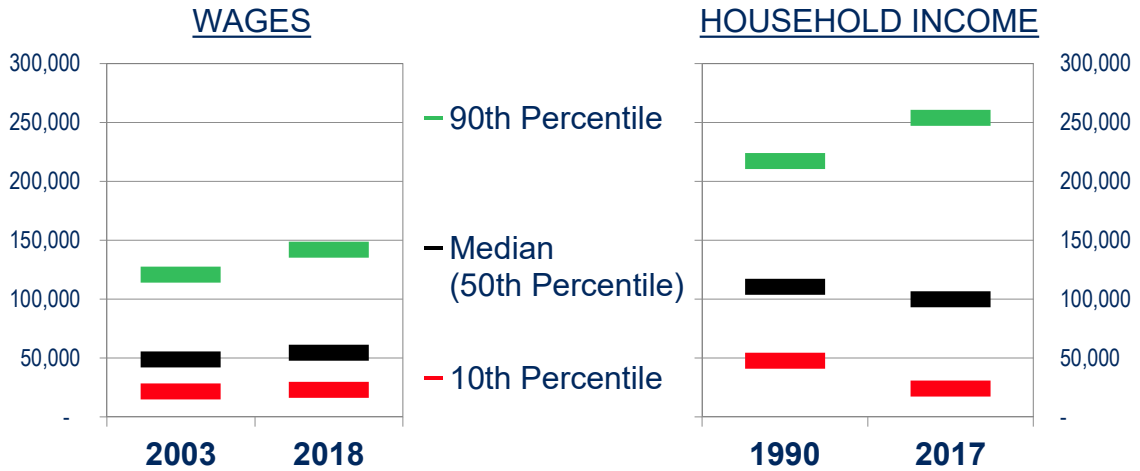
Population Distribution by Age, Arlington County

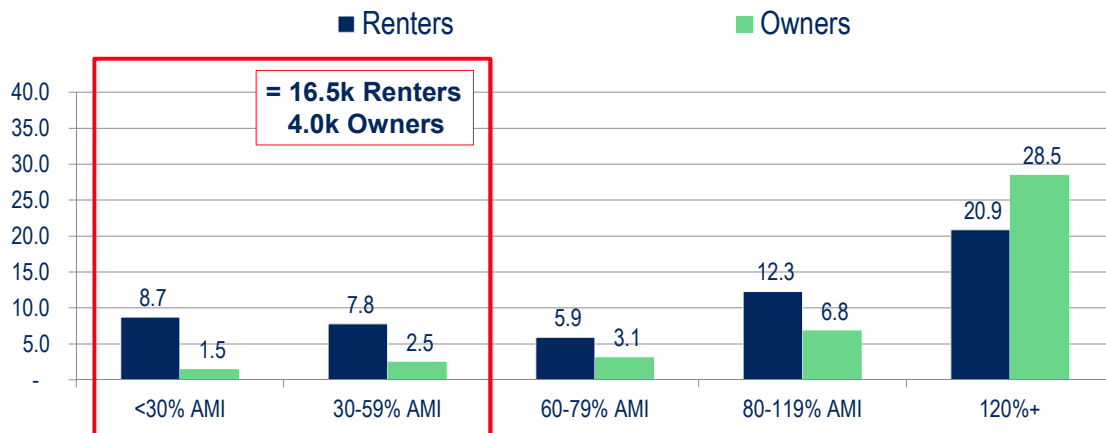
Distribution of Wages & Income, Washington Region

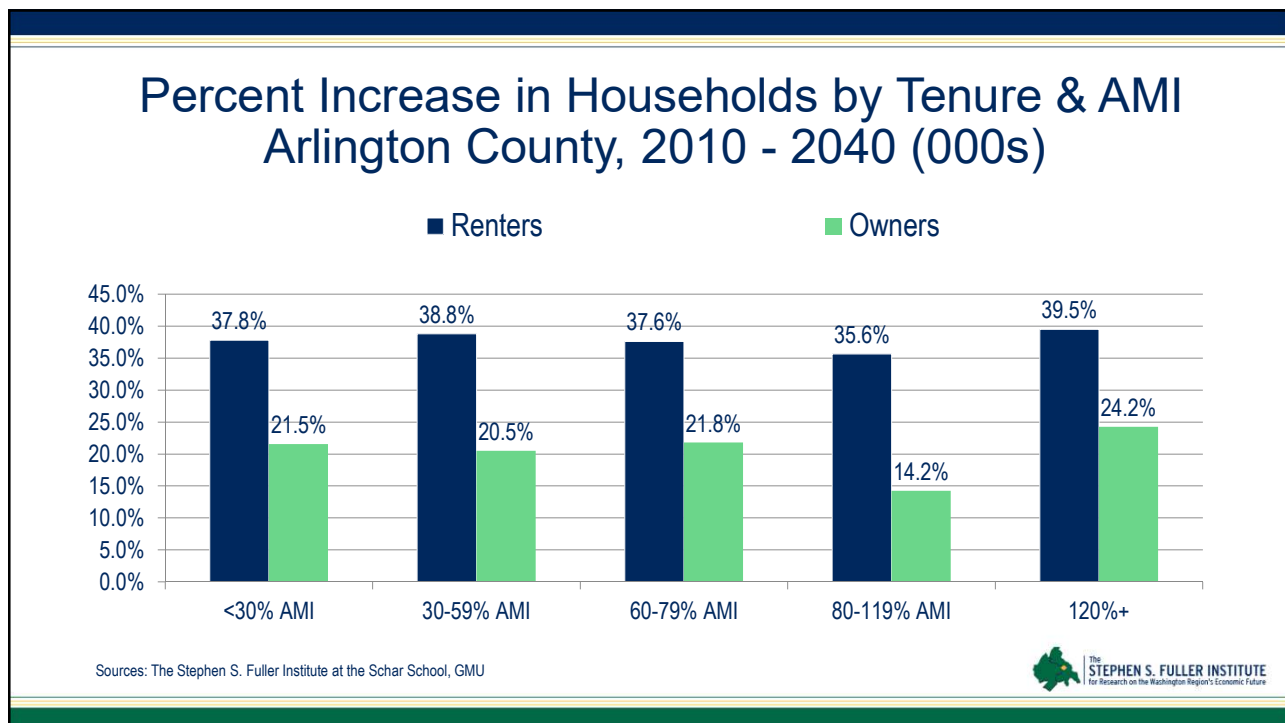
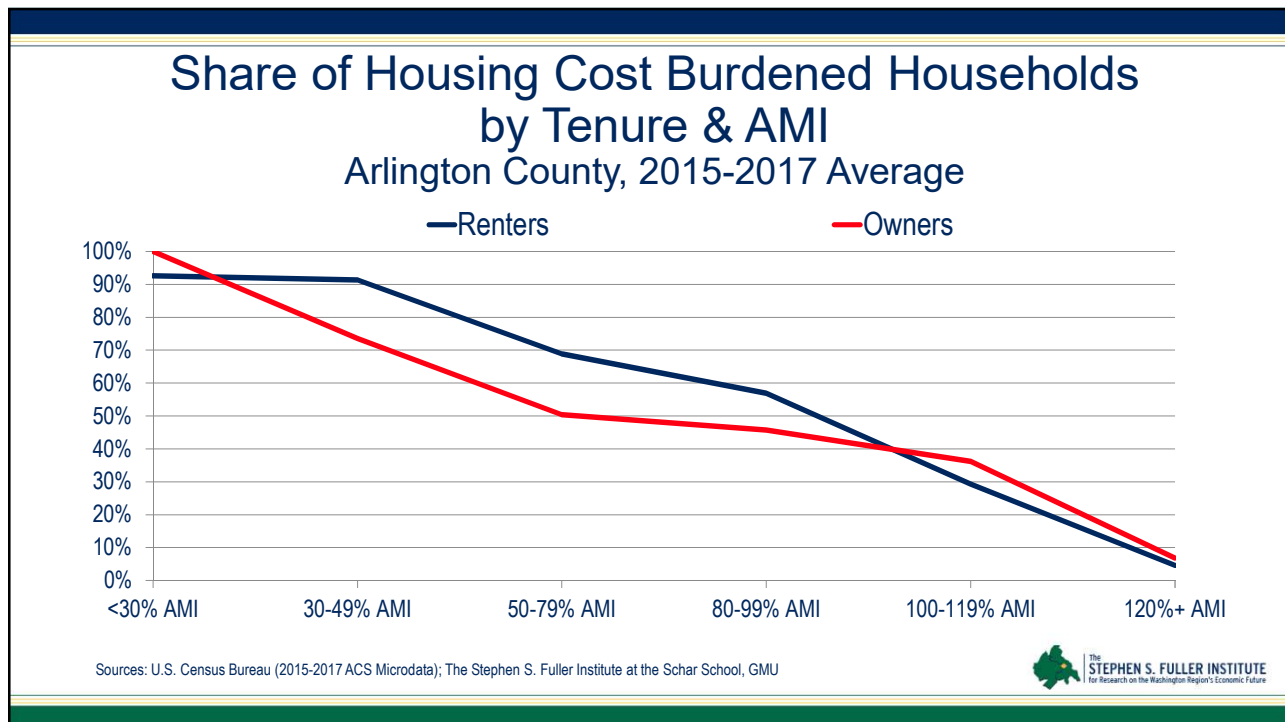


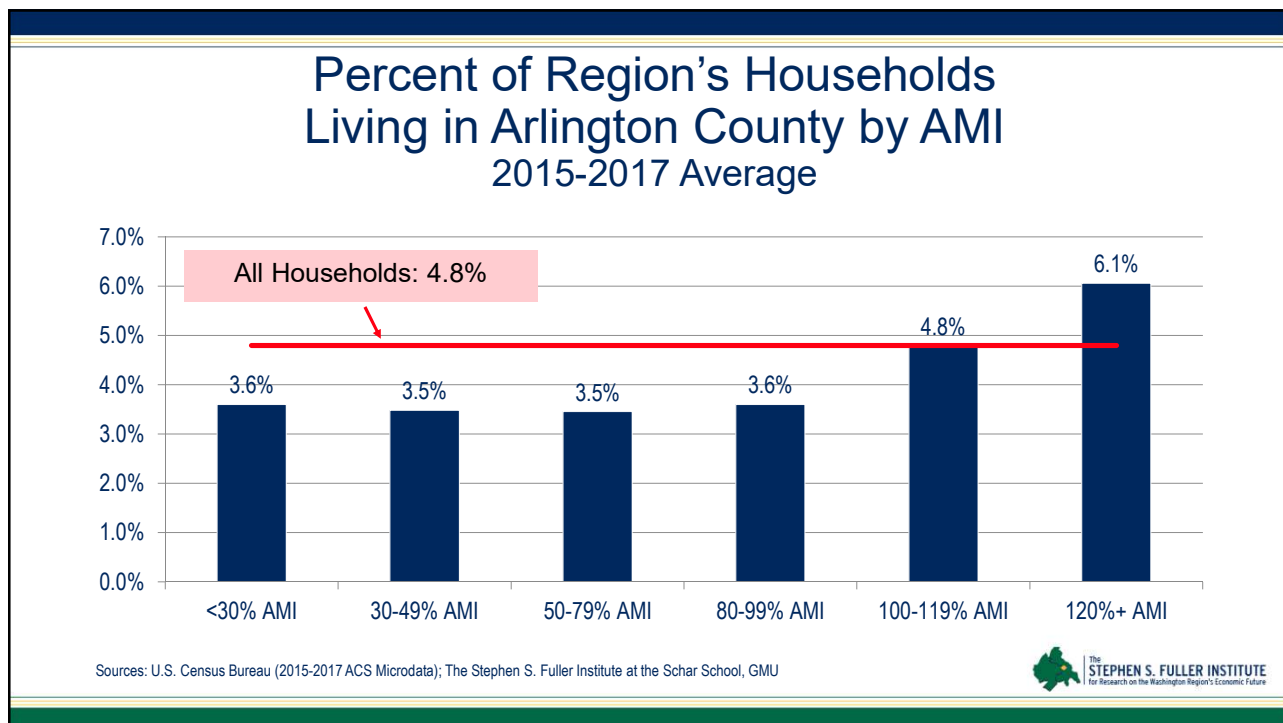
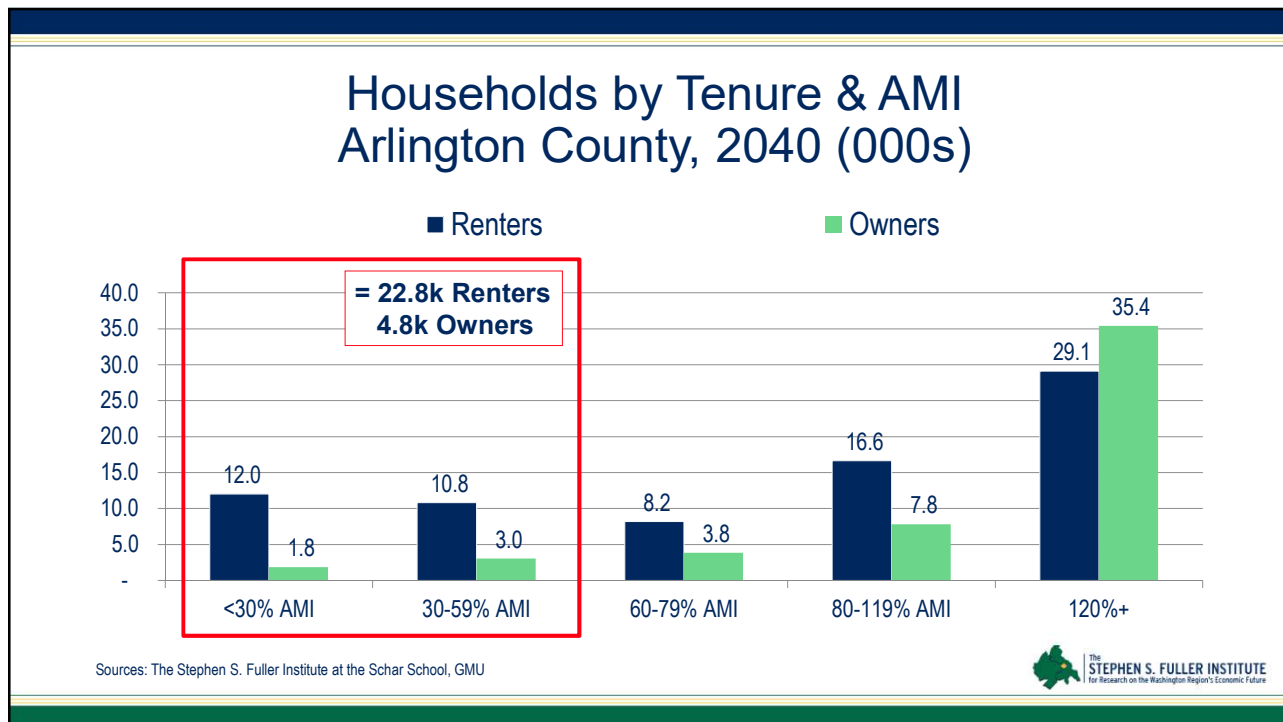
Households by Tenure & AMI Arlington County, 2010 (000s)



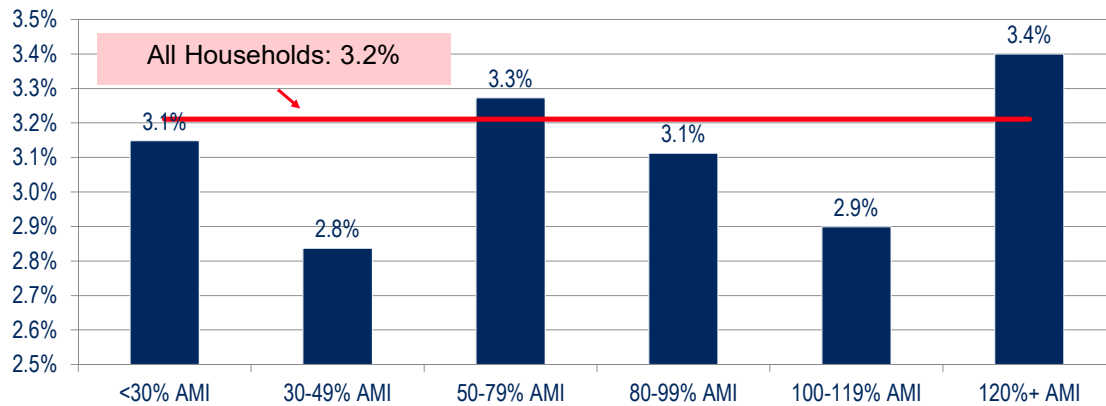
