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


Recession Recovery Patterns of GDP Past Four Recessions*






U.S. Leading Index Month-Over-Year Percent Change




Federal Employment in the Washington Region, 1950-2018


Federal Procurement in the Washington Region, 1980-2018


Federal and Professional & Business Services Jobs Washington Region, 1980 – 2018 (in 000s)


The Changing Structure of the Washington Region Economy


Job Change in the Washington Region 2000 – 2018 (in thousands)


U.S. GDP and Washington MSA GRP 2007 – 2017 (Annual % Change)


Average Annual GRP Change in the Largest Metros 2007-2017 (inflation-adjusted)

U.S. GDP & Washington MSA GRP: 2007-2017 (100 = 2007, adjusted for inflation)










Annual Job Change, 2002-2019 Washington Region









The Changing Structure of the Washington Region Economy




Change in Existing Home Sales Washington Region, Month Over-the-Year


Change in Average Days-On-Market Washington Region, Month Over-the-Year


Change in Unsold Active Listings Washington Region, Month Over-the-Year





Unsold Active Listings Washington Region, August of Each Year




Change in Average Sales Price Washington Region, Quarter Over-the-Year





Existing Home Sales Price By Percentile Washington Region, 1997 – March 2018



Change in Sales By Price Group Washington MSA, Month Over-the Year







