## Washington Region: Changing Generational Sizes











## Population Distribution by Age Washington Region & U.S., 2017






## Washington Region Share of Population Aged 55+ 1980 – 2017 – 2027 (% of Population 15+)





## Washington Region & U.S. Share of Population Aged 55+ 1980 – 2017 – 2026









## Home Owners by Age of Householder and Number\* of Bedrooms, Near-In Washington Region 2014-2016 Average




## Labor Force Participation Rates by Age Washington Region, 2014-2016 Average


## Share of Job-Holders Aged 45+ By Select Sector Washington Region, 2006


## Share of Job-Holders Aged 45+ By Select Sector Washington Region, 2017\*




## Population & Householders by Age NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average


## Household Size & Sex of Householders Aged 65+ NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average (000s)


## Household Type of Householders Aged 65+ NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average (000s)


## Unit Type of Population & Householders Aged 65+ NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average (000s)


## Mobility & Unit Size of Householders Aged 65+ NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average (000s)


## Mobility & Unit Size of Householders Aged 65+ NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average (%)


## Mortgage Status of Owners Aged 65+ NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average (000s)


## Rent of Owners Aged 65+ NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average (000s)


## Employment Status of Population Aged 65+ NUTC Region, 2014-2016 Average


## Industry of Workers Aged 65+ NUTC Region, 2014-2016 Average (000s)




## Disability Status of Population Aged 65+ NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average (000s)


## Age of Population Aged 65+ with a Disability NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average


## Share Population Aged 65+ with a Disability by Age NVTC Region, 2014-2016 Average
