



Jobs in Fairfax County, 2001 - 2018














Average Annual GRP Change in the Largest Metros 2010-2018 (inflation-adjusted)


Growth in the Washington Region's Advanced Industrial Clusters, 2014-2018 Annualized Growth


The Washington Region's Emerging Clusters: Science, Security, Information & Health Technology
